Word Recognition can be administered to all grade levels at all times of the year. Teachers use their discretion to determine when administering the measure will provide additional insight into the student's reading development.The current guideline is to give appropriate instruction in high-frequency words to students who score below 18 on ListC, regardless of grade level. If a student scores above I8 on List C at BOY, there is no need to re-administer the assessment later in the year.
